This is your way to explore it. Becoming a PADI Deep diver also allows you to dive on some of the best ship wrecks Victoria has to offer in the ships graveyard. After one night of theory and 4 boat dives you will be certified to dive to 40m anywhere in the world. This certification counts towards your Master Scuba Diver

Deep Diving Theory Go over your knowledge reviews and find out how to plan your deep dives. You will learn about deep boat dive planning, organisation and equipment configuration, decompression theory, calculating your ideal air consumption for use when diving deep and the

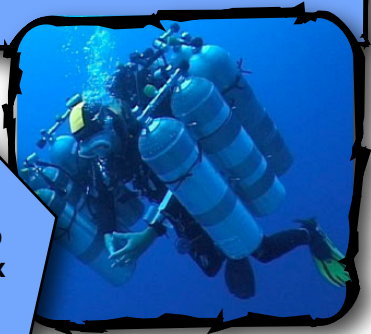
hazards associated with diving below 30m.

Diving You will be completing a timed task at the surface and underwater to show you the affects of nitrogen narcosis. You will also learn about equipment considerations, the affect of depth on objects and the importance of controlled safety stops.

Day 2 of Diving See the difference depth makes on colours, perform emergency decompression stops, control your buoyancy and enjoy the underwater environments that lie beneath 30m.

Mask, snorkel, boots, fins, knife, torch, slate, surface marker buoy, reel.

Divers: At this level of training it is recommended that you are diving in your own scuba unit, as it is the best way for you to fine-tune your buoyancy. However if you do not have your own, rental is available.
